Villa Sandi, Italy

An high quality Prosecco in a gorgeous little bottle. Ideal either to share between two or enjoy all to yourself!

17. Brut Vintage Reserve Sparkling

Chapel Down, England

One of England's best selling sparkling wines originating from Kent. A great example of English Fizz with similar soils to that of Champagne giving the same weight and complexity.

18. L'Universelle Champagne

£40.00

Baron Albert, France

A family owned champagne house ran by three sisters who each run a separate strand of the business. This cuvee contains a large percentage of Pinot Meunier giving an approachable wine with strawberry leaf and citrus aromas.

19. Cuvée Royale Brut

£50.00

Joseph Perrier, France

A remarkable and noble Champagne house still under family ownership. Fresh fruity aromas such as pear and red apple lead to richer fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit. The wine is aged for a minimum of 3 years in their cellars giving complexity and sophistication.

1. Chenin/Sauvignon Blanc

Highveld, South Africa

The nose leads with the Sauvignon aromatics of lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple from the Chenin follows on the palate.

2. Pinot Grigio

La Delfina, Italy

Everybody loves Pinot Grigio with its soft texture, ripe pear and nutty aromas.

3. Sauvignon Blanc

Santa Luz 'Alba', Chile

A crisp, clean and zingy Sauvignon with signature lime and fresh cut grass aromas.

4. Picpoul de Pinet

Beauvignac, France

Elegant aromas of citrus, green apple and fresh herbs with a refreshing mineral palate.

5. Sancerre Blanc

Christian Salmon, France

Clean and pure with a gooseberry and citrus infused nose. The palate is lively and packed with elderberry and grapefruit, finishing with subtle mineral notes. A very elegant wine!

6. Chablis

Fèvre, Burgundy, France

An attractive minerality, steely but with a presence of ripe white fruits. A fine structured wine with beautiful acidity.

7. White Zinfandel Rosé

Californian Rosé bursting with ripe strawberry and juicy watermelon, with a hint of sweetness. .

8. Merlot/Shiraz

Highveld, South Africa

Spicy South African red showing the black pepper synonymous with the Shiraz grape. Earthy tones and ripe bramble flavours in the glass come from the Merlot.

Deep red with rich cherry and black fruit flavours, plenty of structure and ripe tannins.

10. Shiraz

Three Pillars, Australia

Sunshine in a bottle. Jammy fruits of strawberry and blackcurrant with a touch of spice.

11. Malbec

Made in Mendoza, Argentina

Very soft with big ripe red fruit flavours and a peppery finish. Great example of the very popular Argentinean Malbec.

12. Crianza Rioja

Paternina Banda Azul, Spain

Paternina make some of Spain's most popular Rioja in the traditional style. Savoury with leather notes alongside cherry, currants and a touch of vanilla.

13. Vintage Reserve Claret

Cockburns of Leith, Bordeaux, France

A classically styled claret with blackcurrant fruit, fine, firm tannins and hints of vanilla and spice. From the excellent 2015 vintage, the wine is well balanced with good length.

14. Pinot Noir

Maison Jessiaume Bourgogne Pinot Noir, France

Ruby red this Pinot Noir has a inviting bouquet of cherries and raspberries with a nice supple finish. Made by a Scottish owned domaine based in the spa town of Santenay.
